**CORE VALUE 1: Flagstaff Christian School is Family-Focused**

***EXPECTED SCHOOL OUTCOMES FOR VALUE 1***

- FCSO1.1 We partner with families in their child's education and spiritual well-being.
- FCSO1.2 We put the family first in volunteering, chapel, pledges, field trips, and every aspect of our day.
- FCSO1.3 We encourage parent participation through volunteer opportunities, consistent communication, and weekly parent prayer times.

**EXPECTED SCHOOL OUTCOMES FOR VALUE 2**

- FCSO2.1 We value Biblical immersion through all subject matter and relational interaction.
- FCSO2.2 We focus on the heart when the need arises for discipline or encouragement using a Christ-centered, trauma-informed approach.
- FCSO2.3 We build positive character and leadership traits modeled by Jesus Christ and not limited to love, honesty, integrity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, self-control, gentleness, empathy, and faithfulness.
- FCSO2.4 We disciple each and every student in the teachings and love of Christ.

**EXPECTED STUDENT OUTCOMES FOR VALUE 2**

*Spiritual:* Students will have a genuine relationship with Jesus Christ that gives them identity, purpose, and direction in life.

- ESO2.1 Students will have an enduring, life-giving, personal relationship with Jesus Christ and be committed to glorifying God in every aspect of their life.
- ESO2.2 Students will know their unique identity and destiny in Christ and understand the preeminence of Christ in their life.
- ESO2.3 Students will seek to please and bring glory to God in all that they say and do.
- ESO2.4 Students will demonstrate the fruit of the Spirit in their lives, changing the world around them for Christ.

*Biblical Worldview:* Students will study the Bible to know the Truth, including how that impacts their worldview and the validity of other worldviews.

- ESO2.5 Students will be lovers of the Truth, loving and understanding the Word of God, able to correctly differentiate it and apply it to all aspects of life.
- ESO2.6 Students will understand the concept of worldview and be able to identify major elements of the Christian worldview, including themes of creation, fall, redemption, and restoration.
- ESO2.7 Students will be aware of other major worldviews, know how to discern truth from deception, how to identify and interact with the worldviews offered by popular culture, and answer some common attacks upon the Christian faith.

**EXPECTED SCHOOL OUTCOMES FOR VALUE 3**

- FCSO3.1 We individualize education so that each student is learning at their level. This can look like differentiated learning or placement in an advanced core subject area.
- FCSO3.2 We take a holistic approach to educating the child, including their academic, physical, mental, and spiritual growth. We offer athletics, fine arts, mission trips and extracurriculars as ways to develop the whole child.
