WHO

Every student participates! All you have to do is raise as many pledges as you can. Start by asking your friends and family members to make a pledge and join you in supporting this fundraiser. Do not solicit pledges door to door unless you know your neighbors.

HOW

Each student will ride his/her own bike as a class! Participants are encouraged to get sponsors to pledge a specific amount for each checkpoint (every 1/2 mile) reached. Participants will ride through as many checkpoints as they can. For example, if Brett sponsors Tom for \$1 per checkpoint and Tom completes 10 checkpoints, then Brett will donate \$10. Flat rate pledges are also accepted. Contributions are tax deductible, donation letters upon request. Contribute with cash or online at <https://flagstaffchristianschool.org/event/bike-a-thon/>. If your child cannot ride a bike let us know, there will be adults there to teach them. Scooters or other modes of transportation will not be allowed.

Students will be given a 1 or 1.5 hour time slot to ride. When they aren't riding they will be on the baseball fields playing kickball tournament with their grade levels. K-2, 3-6, and 7-HS will have a separate tournament. HS will also have a separate activity after their bike ride.

FUNDRAISING GOAL- \$200 a student

The Bike-a-thon is our largest fundraising event for student activities, sports, and STEM programs at Flagstaff Christian School. Please seek business sponsors and individual sponsors. Pledges should be collected and are due Thursday, Sept 26, 2024 and must be completed online or returned to the Main Office in a sealed envelope.

WHEN

Sept 19, 2024, 8:00am-12pm Parents should plan to drop off and pickup from Foxglenn park. *If the half-day is a hardship, we will offer childcare from 12-3 at South Campus for K-6 (or those with siblings K-6). They will be transported by staff to South campus and then supervised by classroom aides and WILL NOT have academic instruction. Pick-up after 3pm will incur a charge and signup prior to Sept 5 is MANDATORY.
